### Tutor Application

Augustine Literacy Project®-Charlotte trains and supports volunteers who provide free one-on-one instruction in reading, writing and spelling to low-income children. Tutors receive training in a systematic, multi-sensory, phonetic approach to reading and written language and will prepare and deliver 4 practice lessons under the supervision of an experienced tutor/coach.

An Augustine tutor agrees to meet with her/his student twice a week normally during the school day. Tutors meet monthly to exchange ideas, add to their knowledge and skills, and offer one another encouragement and support.

The cost of the training is \$250.00 for those who agree to tutor an aspiring reader for 60 sessions; tutoring materials become the property of the trainee. Please indicate on the application if you require financial assistance. All trainees must pass a background check completed by Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools.
